Kuujuuaq, August 11, 2016 – The Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) is very pleased to announce the launch of its long-awaited new website, www.nrbhss.gouv.qc.ca. All *Nunavimmiut* are invited to go online and have a look. Available in all three languages—Inuktitut, English and French—the website becomes the central platform for anyone looking to obtain more information in regards to the NRBHSS’s mandates and programs.

Users will be able to find several kinds of information on the website such as:

- Description of the NRBHSS’s departments along with their different programs;
- Complaints section;
- Contact information in the health and social services sector across the region;
- Organization chart and listing of the members of the board of directors;
- News-carousel front-page feature to keep the population informed of special events;
- Photo galleries;
- Public-health alerts;
- Press releases and annual reports;
- Documentation on a variety of topics: infectious diseases, nutrition, out-of-region services, etc.;
- And much more.

“We are very excited to present you today with our new website, which we believe will be helpful to anyone looking for information on our organization. We decided on a concise concept and look, where information can easily be found,” said Minnie Grey, Executive Director of the NRBHSS. The colors chosen are those of the NRBHSS’ new logo adopted last year during the annual general meeting.
