Process

Since 2014

Ilusiliriniqmi Pigutjiutini Qimirruniq (IPQ)

- Strengthen coordination and communication on suicide;
- Oversees the deployment of suicide prevention programs;
- Key role in guiding Nunavik suicide prevention strategy

Creation of the Regional Suicide Prevention Committee (RSPC)

Represented by over 20 organizations and associations from Nunavik, all working together for the wellbeing of Nunavimmiut.

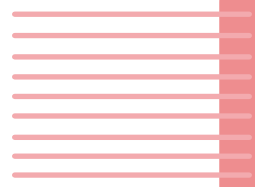
